 \* a minimum of 15 cr. from academic courses  
 \* at least 3 KIN Lab courses (KIN course with a lab component; credits per course may vary)  
 \* a MINIMUM of THREE (3) credits participation in an Experiential Learning setting. The remaining 6 credits can be from either or both categories.

**PHHS students must have C- or better in ALL MAJOR/OPTION COURSES & PRE-REQS**

**PHHS students are allowed at most TWO graded attempts to meet major/option course minimum grade requirements**

**Students wishing to add the Pre-Therapy & Allied Health option must meet the following requirements:**

- Completion of a minimum 90 credits
- Cumulative 3.0 GPA (must be maintained throughout program)
- Minimum 2.7 cum GPA in Anatomy/phys
- No grade less than "C" in ANY Anatomy/Physiology course
