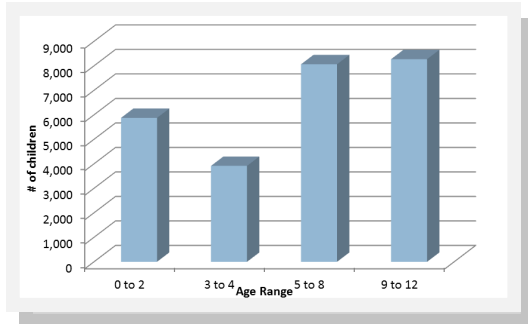


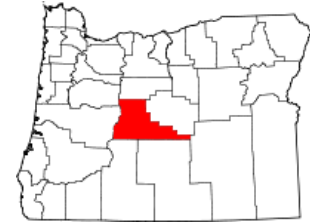
Child Care and Education in Deschutes County

How many children under 13 live in Deschutes County?¹

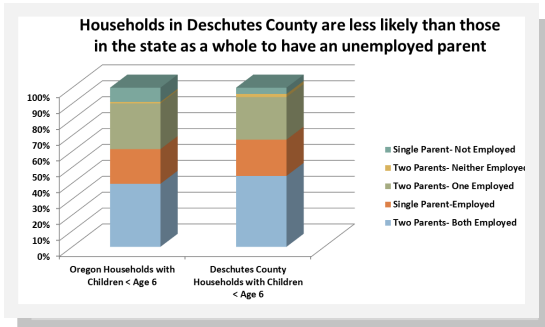


In 2012, there were **26,127** children age 0-12 years:

- ◆ **5,875** children age 0-2
- ◆ **3,916** children age 3-4
- ◆ **8,064** children 5-8
- ◆ **8,272** children 9-12

The following community resources exist for families in Deschutes County:

- ◆ **4,577** slots in child care centers
- ◆ **1,615** slots in family child care homes

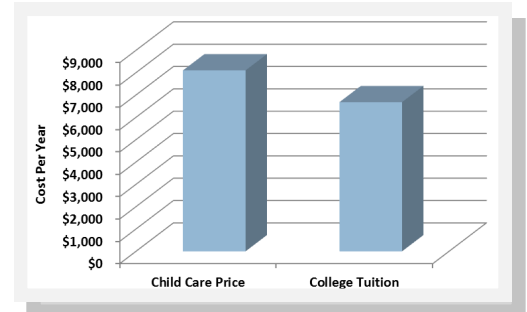
Deschutes County currently has **24** visible slots per 100 children

How much does child care cost?^{4&5}

The price of child care in Deschutes County exceeds the cost of college tuition at Oregon's public universities.

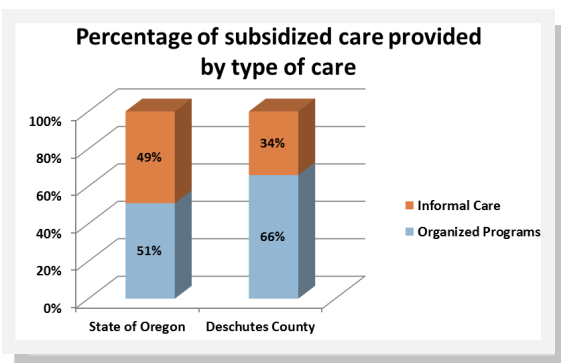
- ◆ Median annual price of child care in Deschutes County \$8,100
- ◆ Average annual price of public university tuition in Oregon \$6,679
- ◆ Care of a toddler as a percent of the annual income of a minimum wage worker 44%



In 2011, child care workers earned a median salary between **\$20,800** and **\$29,120**⁶

On average, families of **398** Deschutes County children per month received a subsidy to help pay for child care in 2012
