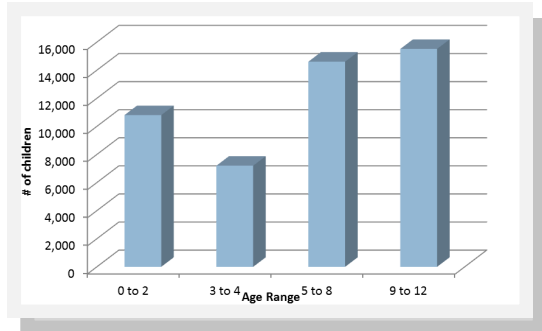


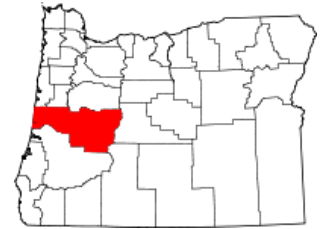
Child Care and Education in Lane County

How many children under 13 live in Lane County?¹

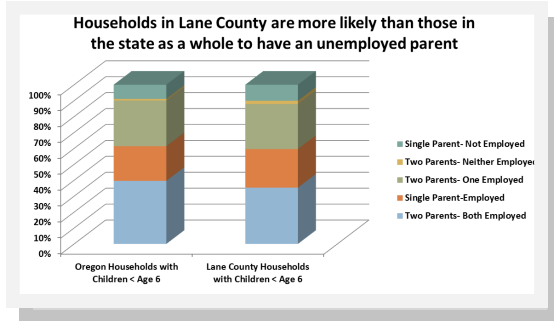


In 2012, there were **48,119** children age 0-12 years:

- ◆ **10,800** children age 0-2
- ◆ **7,200** children age 3-4
- ◆ **14,605** children 5-8
- ◆ **15,514** children 9-12

The following community resources exist for families in Lane County:

- ◆ **6,716** slots in child care centers
- ◆ **2,499** slots in family child care homes

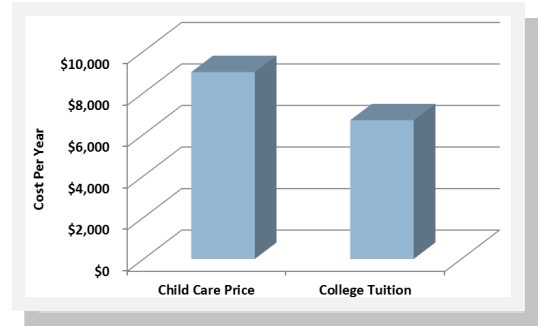
Lane County currently has **19** visible slots per 100 children

How much does child care cost?^{4&5}

The price of child care in Lane County exceeds the cost of college tuition at Oregon's public universities.

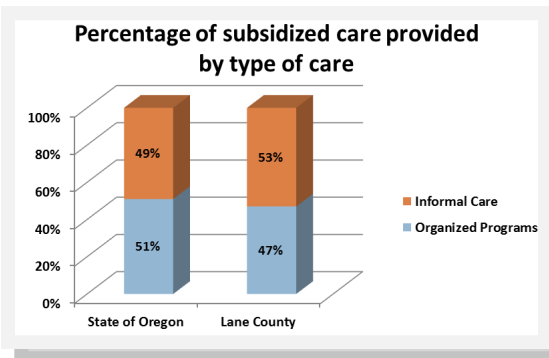
- ◆ Median annual price of child care in Lane County **\$9,000**
- ◆ Average annual price of public university tuition in Oregon **\$6,679**
- ◆ Care of a toddler as a percent of the annual income of a minimum wage worker **49%**



In 2011, child care workers earned a median salary between **\$18,720** and **\$27,040**⁶

On average, families of **1,420** Lane County children per month received a subsidy to help pay for child care in 2012
