Awarded to a CPHHS PhD candidate that will be involved in research and/or writing period of dissertation and/or publication. Recipient must be enrolled full time (9+ credits) F,W, Sp for the academic year of the award.

The College of Public Health and Human Sciences awards 1-2 graduate fellowships per academic year depending on the funding availability. The department specific fellowships have been and will continue to be awarded by departments.

Application requirements: (in order of importance)

- Approved 'Plan of Work' that will be accomplished during the fellowship year and your Dissertation Proposal.
- Feasible timelines and measurable milestones for completion of the planned research.
- Endorsement letter from the major adviser who is on the committee and available to help the student to meet the timelines
- Passed the candidacy exam prior to Fall Term 2017
- Refereed/peer reviewed publications
- Presentations to professional meetings
- Involvement in professional organizations
- Transcript or advising report showing high GPA

Application Procedures:

1. Fill out the application form (below)
2. Based on your approved dissertation research proposal, develop a '**plan of work**' that will be accomplished during the fellowship year. Include the following:
 - **A set of goals, with emphasis on outputs that will result from these goals.** For example, collecting research data, completion of dissertation chapters, write manuscripts if the examination is completed, etc.
 - **A time line for meeting the goals.** For example, collection of research data or experiments by December, completion of dissertation chapters by March, taking examination by April and writing up 2 manuscripts by June.
3. Fellowship recipients have to submit the approved dissertation proposal to the Office of the Executive Associate Dean before the beginning of fall term, 2016 in order to receive the fellowship officially.
4. Fellowship recipients have to pass the qualifying examination before the beginning of Fall 2017 in order to receive the Fellowship officially.
5. Develop or update a C.V. that contains at least the following information:
 - Referred/peer-reviewed publications

- Presentations at professional meetings
 - Involvement in professional organizations
 - Service to OSU
6. Submit application form, plan of work, and C.V. to your major adviser.
 7. The major adviser fills out the Adviser Recommendation Form (forms below)
This includes information on:
 - The adviser's evaluation of the student applicant's ability to meet the goals and timelines articulated in the plan of work
 - The adviser's availability and commitment to advise this student's work within the time period of the fellowship
 8. The major adviser submits the entire application packet to the Dean's Office, 123 Women's Building.
 9. The Associate Dean is responsible for forwarding all application materials to the College Graduate Fellowship Committee.
