1111 participants attended in-person or virtually



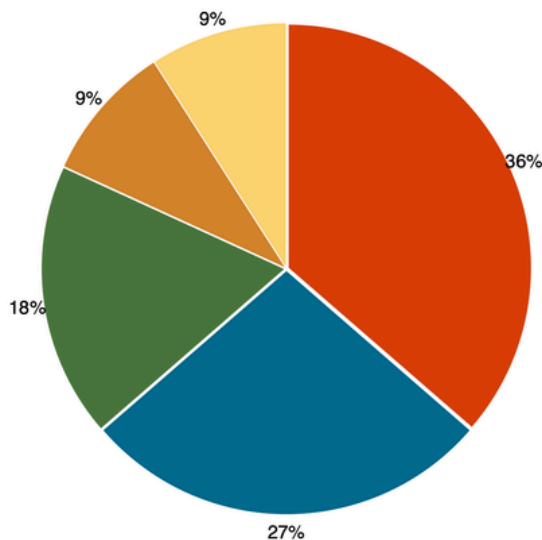
3202 person-hours of training completed



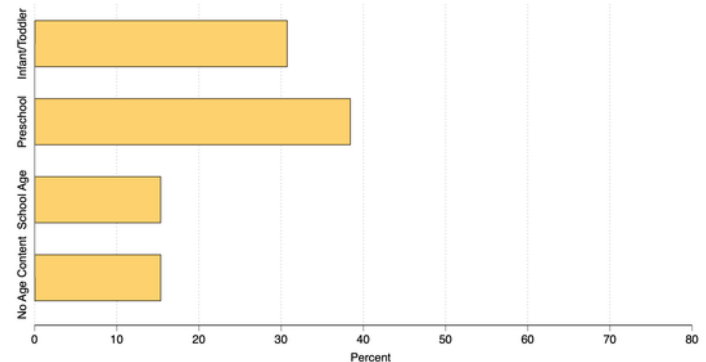
95% stated in evaluations that trainings increased their knowledge

Training Attendance By Core Knowledge Category

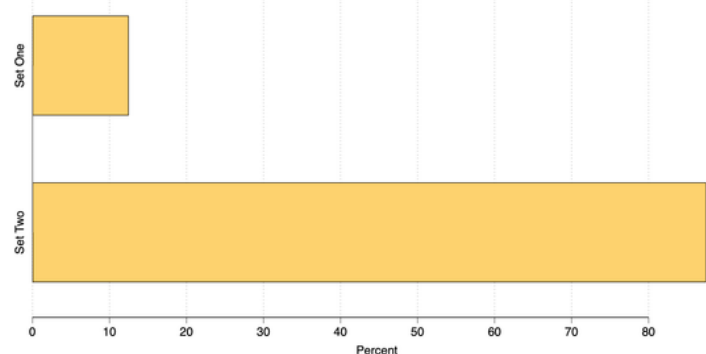
