31 participants attended in-person or virtually



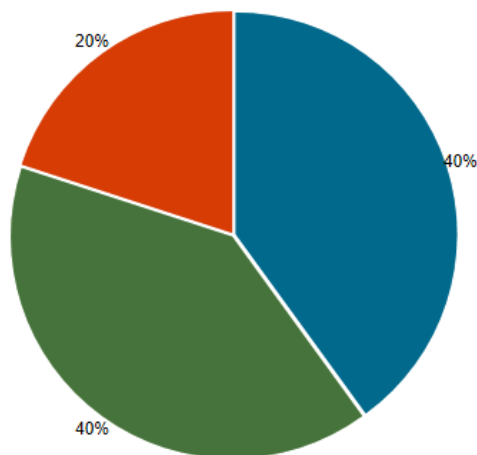
96 person-hours of training completed



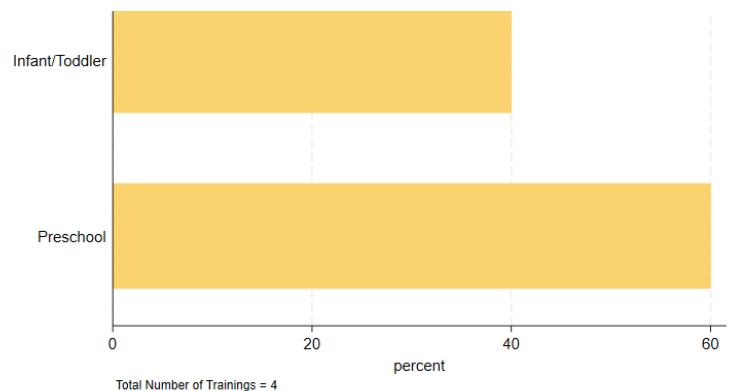
100% of participants stated that trainings increased their knowledge
