- be submitted to CORE.Transitions@oregonstate.edu by 9:00am on Monday
- be connected to an OSU course, program, department, or organization
- include a short bold-font headline
- be under 75 words and include information on the targeted audience*, appropriate links, deadline dates, and contact information
- include hyperlinks within the text rather than a full URL

*Please specify if an announcement is only relevant to a specific Transitions population (100- or 300-level students, on campus or Ecampus).

The CORE Transitions Coordinator reserves the right to edit submissions for style and length or deny submissions that fail to meet these requirements.
