**Typical Course Sequencing and Requirements for MCAT/Med School**

**IMPORTANT:** If you are planning to apply to medical school, you must meet with your pre-med advisor at least two years prior to applying.

\* BI 231-233 + labs (or 300 level). Necessary for KIN & NUTR majors. With a few exceptions, med schools are not looking for A&P as a pre-req but recognize that students who have taken it have an easier time when they encounter it in med school. Non-KIN/NUTR majors should move BI 221-223 up one year if you don't take A&P.

\*\* KIN 343 (fall term only). Required for KIN/PTAH and NUTR/NHS (pre-PA/pre-med track) option, but **required** for **all** PHHS majors w/ pre-med focus who wish to use a Committee Letter. (The application is found on the PHHS PTAH page and due by week 5 of the previous term). See your pre-med advisor for more information.

[MTH 251] as requirement varies by school – it's recommended by some but not required by majority. It's not on the MCAT.

BI 221-223 (211-213) and CH 331/332 are pre-reqs for BI 311, BB/BI 314, MB 302/303

CH 331/332 are pre-reqs for BB 450/ 451

+ Additional courses for MCAT preparation: H 225, PHL 444, SOC 204, ST 351 (or ST 201 or Research Methods courses)
