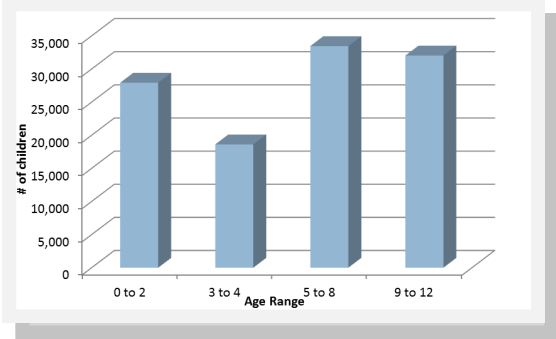


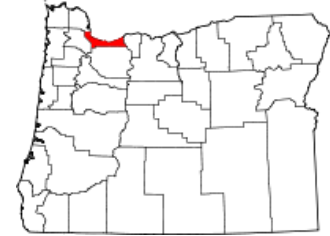
Child Care and Education in Multnomah County

How many children under 13 live in Multnomah County?¹

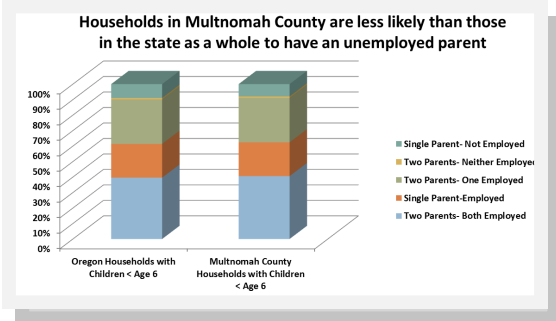


In 2012, there were **112,022** children age 0-12 years:

- ◆ **27,923** children age 0-2
- ◆ **18,616** children age 3-4
- ◆ **33,458** children 5-8
- ◆ **32,025** children 9-12

The following community resources exist for families in Multnomah County:

- ◆ **15,480** slots in child care centers
- ◆ **3,162** slots in family child care homes

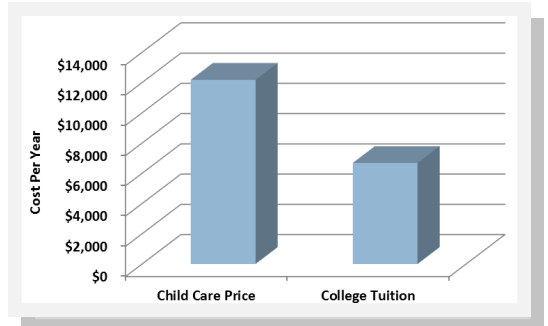
Multnomah County currently has **17** visible slots per 100 children

How much does child care cost?^{4&5}

The price of child care in Multnomah County exceeds the cost of college tuition at Oregon's public universities.

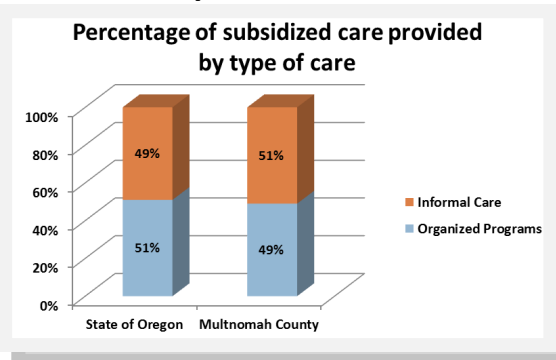
- ◆ Median annual price of child care in Multnomah County \$12,180
- ◆ Average annual price of public university tuition in Oregon \$6,679
- ◆ Care of a toddler as a percent of the annual income of a minimum wage worker 67%



In 2011, child care workers earned a median salary between **\$20,800** and **\$31,200**⁶

On average, families of **2,715** Multnomah County children per month received a subsidy to help pay for child care in 2012
